a) Proposed Employee Handbook Change – Juneteenth Holiday

Human Resources Director Jesse Drucker addressed the Commission regarding the proposed Employee Handbook change. Mr. Drucker explained that the proposed change would add the Juneteenth Holiday to the roster of holidays for non-bargaining employees and give the County Executive the authority to negotiate the holiday with the bargaining units. Mr. Drucker further explained that the proposed change would formalize the arrangement from 2020 that County employees who work on election day as poll workers would receive their regular pay in addition to the Board of Elections stipend.

Chairman Colaluca directed PRC Director Rebecca Kopcienski to draft a letter to communicate the PRC's support of the proposed changes to County Council.
